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PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Implementation research is a growing field that support the identification of health system bottlenecks and approaches to address them, and is particularly useful in low- and middle-income countries where many health interventions do not reach those who need them the most. The goal of this scheme is to enhance postgraduate training capacity and boost the number of researchers in low and middle-income countries.

This two years international master program is started in 2014 and taught in English. Prospective students from Asia and West Pacific Regions can apply for a scholarship from the WHO TDR.

The curriculum is a combination of core curriculum of Public Health Sciences and Tropical Medicine. The core curriculum of Public Health Sciences is in accordance with the Guideline of the Association of Schools of Public Health (ASPH). The curriculum for Implementation Research course is similar with the Implementation Research and Practice course offered by the John Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health.
