HEALTH PROBLEMS AMONG MYANMAR AND LAOS WORKERS AT SAMUT SAKHON, THAILAND

- Background:
 - Increased numbers of workers from Myanmar and Laos migrated to Thailand
 - No previous data of health problem and health care seeking behavior
- Objectives:
 - To identify prevalence of health problems in migrant workers
 - To compare health problems and health care seeking service among Myanmar and Laos workers.
- Methodology: A prospective study
 - Questionnaire-based survey
 - Physical examination by doctors, urine analysis, CXR, VDRL test
- Study site:
 - Migrant Check-Up Clinic, Krathumbaen Hospital, Samut Sakhon

Results

Conclusions

- Prevalence of health problems among migrant workers was 27%
- Laos workers had a higher prevalence of health problems compared to Myanmar (55.7% vs 19.2%)
- Top three health problems
 - Upper respiratory tract infection
 - Diarrhea
 - Tooth decay
- 46.1% of Myanmar and 38.7% of Laos required health care services
- Health problem and health care seeking behavior different among nationalities.
