### INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

From 1990 the Southeast Asian Journal of Tropical Medicine and Public Health has broadened its scope with expansion of traditional areas of interest to give increased coverage of fields such as quantitative epidemiology, health economics, immunology, molecular biology, biotechnology and disease control as they pertain to tropical medicine an public health. This expansion also covers issues relating to the impact of industrialization and economic development on environmental health. To facilitate this broadened spectrum there has been an expansion of the editorial structure and of reviewer panels to provide a wider range of expertise and international coverage.

Papers should be written in English and should be submitted in triplicate, typed on one side of A4 paper in double spacing throughout, with a left-hand margin of 4 cm. Underline words to be printed in italics. Manuscripts should include the title of the paper, given and family names of author (s), name of the institution (s) where the work was carried out and a short running title. Abstract, Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Discussion, Acknowledgements and References should follow. References should be given in the text as all authors when six or less; when seven or more, list only first three and add *et al* plus date; in the list of References they should be given in full in alphabetical order according to the format used by Index Medicus, including first and last page numbers. Research notes should give references in the same format but should not be subdivided into sections.

American spelling will be followed by this Journal, The Editorial Office will endeavor to assist where necessary with English language editing but authors are advised to seek local editing assistance as far as possible before submission.

Tables should follow the format of the Journal: do not cross-hatch, Figures should be drawn clearly in black ink with lettering of appropriate size to allow for reduction; computer-generated graphics are acceptable only if they are done on a high quality laser printer. Photographs must be of high quality in black and white to allow reproduction. Color printing will involve full cost coverage by the authors.

Authors are requested to submit floppy diskette copy together with hard copy manuscirpts to facilitate publication speed: language should be Microsoft Word, or compatible format.

If the manuscript is accepted, page charges will be assessed at the charge of US 30.00 per published page.
